


## *3<sup>rd</sup> ROOT Workshop*

- First Workshop at Fermilab in March 1999
  - Followed the recommendation by the CDF, DO, CD joint working group to adopt ROOT as the standard physics analysis package for RUN II
- Second Workshop at CERN in Feb. 2000
  - Follow-up work led to ROOT v3.0
- Third Workshop -- June 2001
  - Another opportunity for the developers to meet to the ROOT user community
  - Formulate a vision for future ROOT development
